### CONSECRATION TO ST. JOSEPH

This is a 33 day program beginning February 15 with Consecration on March 19 on the Solemnity of St. Joseph at a 6:30pm Mass. Consecration to St. Joseph emulates the tried-and-true preparation method employed by St. Louis de Montfort in his Marian consecration, highlighting many of St. Joseph's titles, privileges, and heroic virtues. What does it mean for a person to be consecrated to St. Joseph? Well, it basically means that you acknowledge that he is your spiritual father, and you want to be like him. To show it, you entrust yourself entirely into his paternal care so that he can help you acquire his virtues and become holy. Total consecration to St. Joseph means you make a formal act of filial entrustment to your spiritual father so that he can take care of your spiritual well-being and lead you to God. The person who consecrates himself to St. Joseph wants to be as close to their spiritual father as possible, to the point of resembling him in virtue and holiness. Saint Joseph, in turn, will give those consecrated to him his undivided attention, protection, and guidance. Books are available at the rectory or at the table in the back of church after Mass for \$9. There are three ways to join, in person each Monday beginning February 15 in the Chapel at 6:30pm, through a ZOOM meeting, or individual study. If preference is to participate through ZOOM, an email address will be required so links can be sent to follow along through the 33 days. ### LIFE OF THE SAINTS

#### STS. SARBELIUS & BARBEA

The Holy Martyrs Sarbelus and Bebaia (Barbea) of Edessa were brother and sister, suffering in the second century under the emperor Trajan for confessing Christianity. Saint Sarbelus was a priest of the idols at Edessa, but was converted to Christ by a certain bishop, then he and his sister were baptized. The soldiers tried to make them give up Jesus by burning them with red-hot irons, but both brother and sisters remained strong in their faith. They were then executed for their faith.
