CONSECRATION TO ST. JOSEPH

This is a 33-day program beginning February 15 with Consecration on March 19 on the Solemnity of St. Joseph at a 6:30pm Mass. Consecration to St. Joseph emulates the tried-and-true preparation method employed by St. Louis de Montfort in his Marian consecration, highlighting many of St. Joseph's titles, privileges, and heroic virtues. What does it mean for a person to be consecrated to St. Joseph? Well, it basically means that you acknowledge that he is your spiritual father, and you want to be like him. To show it, you entrust yourself entirely into his paternal care so that he can help you acquire his virtues and become holy. Total consecration to St. Joseph means you make a formal act of filial entrustment to your spiritual father so that he can take care of your spiritual well-being and lead you to God. The person who consecrates himself to St. Joseph wants to be as close to their spiritual father as possible, to the point of resembling him in virtue and holiness. Saint Joseph, in turn, will give those consecrated to him his undivided attention, protection, and guidance. Books are available at the rectory or at the table in the back of church after Mass for \$9. There are three ways to join, in person each Monday beginning February 15 in the Chapel at 6:30pm, through a ZOOM meeting, or individual study. If preference is to participate through ZOOM, an email address will be required so links can be sent to follow along through the 33 days. LIFE OF THE SAINTS

ST. MOSES

St. Moses was an Arab hermit and bishop who is called "the Apostle of the Saracens." He lived in the desert regions of Syria and Egypt, caring for the local nomadic tribes. When the Romans imposed peace upon the Saracens, Queen Mavia, the Saracen ruler, demanded that Moses be consecrated a bishop. He accepted against his will and maintained the peace between the Saracens and Rome. The Saracens were a nomadic people of the Syro-Egyptian desert so designated by the Romans. His feast day is February 7.
