LIVES OF THE SAINTS—ST. MICHAEL MY

Martyr of Vietnam. He was the mayor of a town in Vietnam when the persecution of Christians started. Michael was martyred with Blessed Anthony Dich, his son-in-law, and with St. James Nam. He was canonized in 1988 by Pope John Paul II with 116 other Vietnamese Martyrs also known as the Martyrs of Annam, Martyrs of Tonkin and Conchinchina, Martyrs of Indochina, or Andrew Dung-Lac and Companions.
