DIVINE MERCY NOVENA BEGINS GOOD FRIDAY

St. Faustina prayed the Chaplet of Divine Mercy almost constantly, especially for the dying, and the Lord urged her to encourage others to say it, too, promising extraordinary graces to those who would recite this special prayer. The Chaplet can be said anytime, but the Lord specifically asked her that it be recited as a novena, especially on the nine days before the Feast of Mercy. The nine days before the Feast of Mercy begins on Good Friday. He promised, "By this Novena (of Chaplets) I will grant every possible grace to souls." We can pray this Novena of Chaplets for our own personal intentions, or we can offer it together with the Novena to Divine Mercy for the daily intentions dictated by our Lord to St. Faustina. Each day we will have an intention to bring to the Lord of different groups and immerse them in His unfathomable mercy. **Day 1 (Good Friday)**—all mankind, especially all sinners, **Day 2**—souls of the priests and religious, **Day 3**—all devout and faithful souls, **Day 4**—those who do not believe in God and those who do not yet know the Lord, **Day 5**—the souls of those who have separated themselves from the Church, **Day 6**—the meek and humble souls and the souls of little children, **Day 7**—the souls who especially venerate and glorify My Mercy, **Day 8**—the souls who are detained in purgatory, **Day 9**—souls who have become lukewarm
