THE FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY

The feast of Divine Mercy is on the first Sunday following Easter, also called the Second Sunday of Easter. Jesus told St. Faustina "On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are opened. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy (*Diary, 699*). Regarding the graces of Divine Mercy Sunday, Jesus told St. Faustina, "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins & punishment"(699). **To receive the grace of Divine Mercy Sunday, you simply need to go to Confession before or on the day of the feast – sometime during Lent suffices; be in the state of grace on Divine Mercy Sunday itself (no mortal sin); and receive Holy Communion with the intention of obtaining the promised grace.** Another beautiful element of Divine Mercy Sunday is that the Church also gives us the opportunity to receive a plenary indulgence attached to an act of worship of the Divine Mercy or participation in a Divine Mercy service on the same day that we can offer for ourselves or for a Holy Soul in Purgatory. ***There will be a Divine Mercy Prayer Service at 3pm at St. George.*** We will not be offering Holy Communion or Confessions at the prayer service, so please try to attend Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday to receive communion.
