NOTRE DAME RENOVATIONS

A storm in February damaged the roof of Notre Dame Hall pulling off shingles in several places and causing leaking into the upper level of the building. Our property insurance is covering the vast majority of the expense to replace the shingled portion of the roof and repair/reinforce the seams of the flat portion of the roof. We also received a grant to help us add AC to the loft area where CYO gathers, add a fire escape to the third floor, and install in new flooring in that space. We hope the work will start in the next few weeks.
