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Lunch payment is currently \$42.20 per month. However there could be a possibility that would increase. I will keep you posted.

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Band payments are \$30 per month per student.

**Since we have a new grading scale, we will be using a different method for calculating GPA, top and second honors at the end of the school year. We will no longer be on a 12 point scale, but we will be on a 4.00 point GPA scale. This will be used to help in the determination of top and second honors at the end of the school year.**

**Students from PK-2 are still on a standards based report card. Remember this is not cumulative nor is it a percentage. The following diagram helps to explain the standard based learning:**

**4 -The student, with limited errors, understands key concepts, processes, and skill applies them effectively.**

**3-The student is progressing towards understanding key concepts, processes and skills, but demonstrates inconsistent application of concepts independently.**

**2-The student is demonstrating progress towards understanding and application of key concepts, processes and skills with additional time and support.**

**1-The student is not demonstrating progress towards understanding of key concepts, processes and skills even with additional time and support.**

**\*-Skills not assessed at this time.**

## Drop Off and pick up procedures:

Doors open at 7:00 am. When dropping off your child, pull up to the lobby doors. Have the children exit on the passenger side of the car. We will have door greeters that will help your child get in the building. If you need to walk your child in, pull into a diagonal parking space and park. If you do this it will not interfere with the flow of traffic.

Pick up procedure will be relatively the same. Parents will pull in from Benton street. At the sign we will start forming a triple line then we zipper in to ensure the safety of not having cars stuck on Highway 50. Please be patient during this process. Teachers are very efficient in getting children in the correct car, but we ask you to be patient. We will start loading cars between 3:10 pm-3:15 pm. If you don't want to wait in the line or don't want to zipper in, you are welcome to come around 3:20. At this time, there will either be a small line or not a line at all.
