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Protecting young eyes: Oct 18 we will be having a Protecting Young Eyes presentation. Please note the following change on sports eligibility to reflect the change in the Diocese grading scale. The following change will be in the Student Handbook:  
**Eligibility in Co-Curricular Activities (LSR 6603)**

Unless special arrangements are made with the pastor or principal, any student/family who has delinquent lunch, bus, registration or any other fees from the previous school year, will not be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities during the current school year until those fees have been paid in full.

Students must be in attendance for ½ of the school day, to include lunch, to attend or participate in extra-curricular activities held that day or evening. Special cases may warrant the principal's discretion and may receive permission - i.e. funeral leave, delays in appointments, etc.

All participants must have a 67% or above in every subject area in order to be able to play. Parents and coaches will receive a notice that a student is not allowed to participate until the grades are above 67% or at the discretion of the administration.

All participants in athletic programs must have a completed physical form on file with the Athletic Committee before participating in practices or games. Additionally, all participants in the athletic program must have fees paid and verification and release of liability forms on file before participating in practices or games.
