Over the past few weeks we have been praying for the Lord to direct us in how to use our gifts & talents. You will find CSR packets in the back of church or for those that prefer electronic means can scan the QR code in the bulletin or on the stewardship prayer cards in the pews or click the CSR banner on the parish website.
