St. George Scrip Program



What is the Scrip Program?

The St. George Scrip Program is a fundraiser run by parish volunteers to raise money to cover the school copier usage fees and maintenance costs. School families and parish programs have the opportunity to earn a rebate to help support individual school registration fees and parish program expenses.

How does it work?

The Scrip Program is gift card fundraising. The St. George Scrip Program purchases gift cards from RaiseRight or local vendors at a reduced rate and sells them for their face value. The amount of money that the scrip program earns on each card is then split with 35% of the amount going toward the school registration or parish program of your choice and the remaining 65% goes into the Scrip account to pay all the copy machine expenses for the school, donations for parish fundraisers, and replenish inventory of physical cards. Scrip rebates to school registration or parish programs are paid out annually at the end of the scrip year which runs April 1 – March 31.

For example: The parish purchases a \$100 Thriftway card for \$96. A St. George Scrip Program customer then purchases the card for \$100 and designates the rebate to go towards their grandchild's school registration fees for the next school year. Of the \$4 earned, \$1.40 (35%) goes towards their grandchild's registration and \$2.60 (65%) stays in the Scrip program to pay school copy machine fees and maintenance.

What types of Scrip can we purchase?

Scrip gift cards can be purchased as physical gift cards or electronic gift cards that store in your scrip wallet on the RaiseRight app. If you are ordering the cards from the RaiseRight app, please make sure you select the type of card you want. We carry a limited stock of physical gift cards from local vendors and most popular vendors.

How can I place an order?

You can order physical cards in two ways. First, you can complete a St. George Scrip Order Form and include cash or check payment at the Scrip table before and after Saturday evening and Sunday morning Mass in the back of church. If you are ordering items that are in stock, the volunteer will fill your order immediately. During the week, you can send your order form and payment into the parish office where volunteers will fill orders on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Items that are not in stock will need to be special ordered and will require 1-2 weeks to receive the cards to fill the special orders. Special orders are placed on Monday after 3pm; therefore if you have a special order, it is good to place your orders early. The second way is through the RaiseRight app. You can download the RaiseRight app on your smart phone or visit www.shopwithscrip.com and enroll under our St. George School enrollment code L79DB9E94565 or scan the QR code. Through RaiseRight, you can pay by check sent to the parish office (your order will not be filled or special orders placed until payment is received), pay by bank draft, or pay by credit card. Fees apply for using electronic payment methods, but those orders will be filled when our next volunteer is available.



How else can I support the Scrip Program?

If you shop at Gerbes, they have a Community Rewards Program. You will need to download the Gerbes app and set up an online account with your Gerbes Plus Card. In your account, click on the three lines at the top left of the screen. From that menu select Rewards > Community Rewards and enter ST GEORGE SCHOOL as your organization. That's it! Each quarter, Gerbes will send the program a check and post the amount of rewards you earned during that quarter in your app. Send a screenshot of the amount earned in your app to the scrip coordinator at sgscrip@yahoo.com and she will credit that rebate to your chosen school registration or parish program.
