Summer Care

- *Date of service: May 20, 2024- August 2, 2024*
- *During summer school 5/20-6/21, summer care will be available all day on Monday (7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.) and after school on Tuesdays thru Fridays.*
- *We ask that children bring their lunch each day and an afternoon snack. Please have your child's name on his/her lunch bag. We can store the bags in the refrigerator if necessary, as well as warming up items in the microwave when needed.*
- *Breakfast will not be served this year.*
- *Bus afternoon drop-off will be 3:05 p.m. - 3:10 p.m*
- *We will be going to the pool during summer school on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Please pick up your child at the pool on those days. Your child is welcome to bring a snack from home or money for the concession stand. Please send a towel with your child as well as sunscreen with his/her name on it. The sunscreen will be stored at school until summer care is over.*
