The first day that students can wear shorts is March 25th. Please remember that just because the shorts fit in August doesn't mean that they fit now. As per our policy:

Bottoms: Solid navy or tan khaki skirts, jumpers, walking shorts, capris or pants. They must fit appropriately - not too tight or too loose. Belts are required if the clothing has belt loops. Shorts must be at least knee-length (Bermuda shorts). Skirts and jumpers must be knee length. Shorts may not be worn during the second quarter and the third quarter. Girls wearing skirts during those quarters must wear uniform colored tights.

Please remember that pants still need to be worn on Mass days and it will be at teacher discretion as to whether or not students are allowed to change into shorts after Mass.

As we wrap up basketball, I would like to take the time to recognize some moments that showcases how sports can be part of our mission of being Christ-centered and faith-directed in all that we are!
