Devotion to the Sacred Heart also involves acts of reparation for sins against Jesus's love, promoting penance and conversion. The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus plays a vital role in Catholic spiritual life, encouraging the faithful to draw closer to the compassionate heart of Christ.
