Mass Expectations

As a faith-based institution, we place a strong emphasis on spiritual development. All students are expected to attend Mass, and we invite parents to join us in worship. All students will go to Mass on Wednesday and the first Friday of the month. Students in grades 5-8 will go to Mass every Friday. When attending Mass as school, we expect all students to wear a navy shirt with khaki bottoms. We encourage families to participate actively in these spiritual gatherings. We also expect our families to fulfill their Sunday obligation of attending Mass on either Saturday night or on Sunday morning.

Building updates:

- The blocks at the back of the school have been completed.
- Mold has been abated.
- New drywall and insulation have been put up.
- We are hoping to paint next week.

- We are also working on the prayer garden in front to make it more aesthetically pleasing and more user friendly for all. Part of this process will be to remove the old blocks and replace those to match what is near the electronic sign. If you would like to purchase one of those old blocks, they will be \$1.00 a piece. If you want some, just contact Mrs. Grellner. All the money collected will be put back into this project.

Open House will be on August 11th. We will be hosting a parent meeting at 9:15 a.m. in Church Hall. This is prior to the starting of Mass. Once Mass is over, we will have classrooms open and the Knights of Columbus will be hosting a BBQ.

Chop House Grille is having a fundraiser to help us with the cost of the building repairs. On August 7th from 4:00pm to 8:00 pm, Chop House Grille will donate all tips and 10% of the proceeds to help St. George with the building repairs that we are facing. Please come out and help support our maintenance project.

What is the Scrip Program?

The St. George Scrip Program is a fundraiser run by parish volunteers to raise money to cover the school copier usage fees and maintenance costs. School families and parish programs have the opportunity to earn a rebate to help support individual school registration fees and parish program expenses.

How does it work?

The Scrip Program is gift card fundraising. The St. George Scrip Program purchases gift cards from RaiseRight or local vendors at a reduced rate and sells them for their face value. The amount of money that the scrip program earns on each card is then split with 35% of the amount going toward the school registration or parish program of your choice and the remaining 65% goes into the Scrip account to pay all the copy machine expenses for the school, donations for parish fundraisers, and replenish inventory of physical cards. Scrip rebates to school registration or parish programs are paid out annually at the end of the scrip year which runs April 1 - Mar 31, 2024
