Attendance Policy

Stewardship and Involvement

At St. George, we believe in the importance of stewardship and being actively involved in our parish community. We encourage all parents to engage in various school activities and volunteer opportunities. There will be sign-up sheets in the gym on the different ways in which you could contribute and volunteer around the school and parish. As a faith-based institution, we place a strong emphasis on spiritual development. All students are expected to attend Mass, and we invite parents to join us in worship. All students will go to Mass on Wednesday and the first Friday of the month. Students in grades 5-8 will go to Mass every Friday. We encourage families to participate actively in these spiritual gatherings. We also expect our families to fulfill their Sunday obligation of attending Mass on either Saturday night or on Sunday morning.

Dress Code

A key aspect of our school culture is the dress code. It promotes discipline, respect, and a sense of belonging. Please ensure that your child adheres to the dress code guidelines outlined in the student handbook. This consistency helps create an environment conducive to learning and respect. One thing that has changed in the dress code is students can wear shorts or skirts to Mass with navy shirts. Students are allowed to wear St. George sweatshirts in classrooms. However it needs to be the sweatshirts that are purchased through the school. All other sweatshirts with our name/logo can only be worn on Thursdays. Thursday is our Warrior apparel day.-Students can wear their St. George t-shirts or St. George sports t-shirt.
