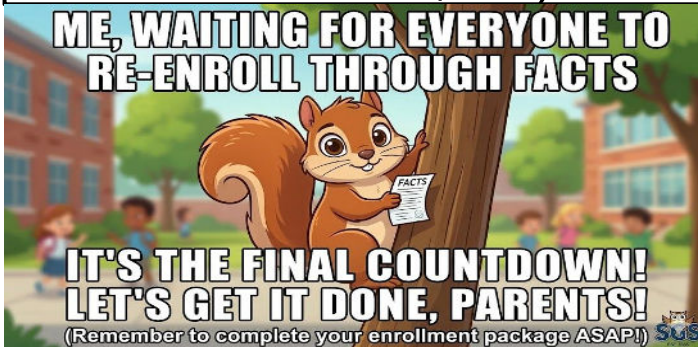

Students who complete Summer Solutions books, with a quick review three times a week, stay on track throughout the summer months. Without review and practice over the summer break, children forget much of what they learned in school. This phenomenon is sometimes called the "summer slide".

We will place an order through the school on Friday, April 12th. If you place your order by Thursday, April 10th, your books will be \$16.75, and there is no charge for shipping. If you are interested in purchasing Summer Solutions, or if you have any questions, please send an email to Mrs. Grellner and she can discuss what would benefit your child the most.
